

Certificate of Biblical Studies

Purpose

The Certificate of Biblical Studies program is designed for those who are not able to pursue a standard seminary degree program due to lack of necessary undergraduate preparation or because of personal circumstances. Qualified students may count certificate credits toward bachelor's equivalency.

Objectives

To enable the student to demonstrate:

- a. A general knowledge of the Bible and Biblical interpretation
- b. A general knowledge of conservative Christian theology
- c. Biblical bases for the local church, evangelism, and missions

Admission

The applicant must have two years of college education or the equivalent and two years of ministry experience. Special consideration is given to those over 30 years of age with extensive ministry experience.
